



Our experience

We are a multi-disciplinary team combining years of industry experience to provide comprehensive evidentiary solutions.

Our team of accountants, data analysts, digital experts and former law enforcement officers is called upon to uncover, analyse and clarify crucial information. Typically, the KordaMentha forensic team is called upon when the commercial stakes are high, the facts are unclear and an acute evidentiary problem needs to be solved.

The facts we uncover can change the course of events. It can be the impetus to start conciliation, as legal evidence if matters proceed to court or as a basis for a financial settlement between warring parties. Sometimes our role is to provide the evidence to build a case; other times we act as a bridge between opposing parties to allow them to continue working together in the future.





Exposing overstated contractor claims

With construction cost blowouts in the hundreds of millions of dollars and two parties in a heated dispute, the Forensic team unlocked insights from hundreds of complex and interrelated delay and variation claims, helping to resolve a stalemate.

Outcomes

Using our customised model and visualisations, the principal was able to view the project at both a macro and micro level to investigate areas of the project that required clarification.

The principal and their legal representatives were in a position where they could replace suspicions and confusion with facts and evidence, based on the contractor's own data. The principal was now able to answer questions, such as:

- What was the basis for the claims and supporting evidence?
- Were any of the claims overstated or duplicated on the project?
- Did the contractor's own data support the claims made by the contractor?

Our analysis and visualisations were used as part of the negotiations between the parties, which helped the parties settle the matter on confidential terms.

Overview

Our client was the principal in a contract to construct a multi-billion-dollar project in the coal sector. The contractor claimed cost variations and delays worth over \$500 million, leading to a series of hard-fought claims and cross-claims between principal and contractor.

The principal was suspicious of the reasons underlying the delay and variation claims. However, given the sheer volume of the information that confronted them, they could not verify those suspicions.

Our approach

The question asked of us was simple – were the contractor's claims supported by the contractor's own data? The solution was complex.

Bringing together a multi-disciplinary team of forensic accountants, data analysts and quantity surveyors, we converted all relevant information sources, including more than 20,000 hard copy timesheets, into a standard electronic format for comparison. The claims were matched, cleansed and integrated into a model that could be compared against the timesheet data and other independent data sources.

Investigation into directors' alleged corruption

The breadth of our forensic offerings – digital forensics, eDiscovery, investigations and dispute resolution – assisted our client to uncover the extent of interested party transactions which benefited certain rogue directors, and to successfully claim damages against the directors in legal proceedings.

Outcomes

- We identified seven entities which the rogue directors appeared to have beneficial interest in.
- We uncovered evidence of the rogue directors receiving benefits from the interested party transactions, and of employees who were moonlighting or enabled the interested party transactions to occur.
- Within a month of our engagement, we produced a preliminary findings summary report which assisted the client in commencing an action against the rogue directors and their related entities.
- Upon further engagement, our dispute resolution experts assessed the alleged damages suffered and provided expert witness evidence at trial. Where the Court established that liability and causation had been proven, the damages we assessed were largely accepted by the Court.

Overview

Our client had acquired a majority stake of a hostel and serviced apartment business including seven operating entities and a holding company. Management of the business remained the responsibility of the founding shareholder and his family members, who were minority shareholders and directors.

After the profit warranty was met, the business declined and eventually registered losses. Our client engaged us to investigate the affairs of the business and, based on our findings, a suit against the rogue directors was initiated. We were further instructed to assess the damages suffered by our client.

The Court found that the rogue directors had breached:

- Their fiduciary duties by diverting business opportunities to their own related entities
- Their duty to act in the best interest of the business by misusing business resources
- The no-conflict rule by procuring their own related entities to provide services to the business and then receiving personal benefits.


Our approach

We took swift action, attending the client's premises the same day following instruction to act. Our digital forensic team imaged eight computers and three servers. Physical documents collected were converted to electronic data by our eDiscovery team, with all electronic data then processed and hosted on our eDiscovery platform. The eDiscovery process enabled us to effectively identify documents that were relevant to the matter from amongst approximately 600,000 documents. It was also important to ensure that physical evidence was captured on-site to support factual circumstances of the investigations and substantiate evidence given in court. Our forensic collection of the evidence and the presentation of the facts at trial was crucial to the success of the litigation.

Our ability to provide an expert to quantify damages made it more efficient for the client to instruct us as we had intimate knowledge of the matter. However, to maintain our independence and minimise the threat of self-review, we utilised a different team and quantification expert within the firm. We do more than just provide the numbers. We identify unforeseen areas of interest, assess and evaluate the impact and advise the best path for resolution.

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
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
